LICENSE/CERTIFICATE CODES

SELECTION OF LICENSE/CERTIFICATE CODE:

Choose the code that best represents the respondent being cited. Choose only one, individual or business code. A check box is provided on the form to indicate whether an individual or business was unregistered at the time of the incident.

INDIVIDUAL LICENSE/CERTIFICATION CODES

State Codes:

The license and certificate codes are self-explanatory. Information about DPR issued licenses/certificates can be found at <www.cdpr.ca.gov> under licensing. Information about structural licenses can be found at <www.dca.ca.gov/pestboard> under regulations. Information on vector control can be found at <http://www.cdph.ca.gov/programs/vbds/>

County Codes:

The county codes are: operator identification (**OID**), private applicator certificate (**PAC**), and restricted materials permit (**RMP**). While in most cases OIDs and RMPs are issued to business entities, they can be issued to individuals.

County Codes:

The county codes are operator identification (**OID**) and restricted materials permit (**RMP**). Use the appropriate code.

LICENSE/CERTIFICATE CODES

Not Required (NR): Business/Individual not required to have a license with DPR.

Unlicensed (UNL): Business/Individual is not licensed with DPR.

Uncertified: (UNC): Only apply to individuals.
