DPR will only disclose personally identifiable information, such as home phone number and personal email address, to third parties as required by state or federal law or regulation and consistent with the Information Practices Act (Civ. Code, sections 1798-1798.78).

Application Type: Check the appropriate box(es).

New Application: If you:

- ✓ *Are applying for a Qualified Applicator Certificate for the first time.
 ✓ Failed to obtain your confidence in the first time.
- Failed to obtain your certificate within 12 months from the first date you scheduled your examination.

To qualify for this exemption, you must enter the number from your current license or certificate next to the (1) exemption[you must enter the number from your current license or certificate next to the (1) exemption], OR (2) have passed the Laws, Regulations, and Basic Principles-Eexam within one (1) yearthe last 12 months, or (3) you are applying for a QAC-Q certificate only.
- Examination Category(ies): Indicate the category(ies) you want to take by checking the appropriate box(es). In addition to the Laws, Regulations, and Basic Principles examination, each new applicant must successfully pass at least one of the pest control categories (A-PM or Q) before a Qualified Applicator Certificate is issued. Applicants seeking certification only in subcategory Q do not need to take the Laws. Regulations, and Basic Principles examination. AYou may only select a maximum of four (4) examinations may be scheduled per location per application, including the Laws, Regulations, and Basic Principles examination, and you may only test once per month. You may only apply once per month, exceptions to this are evaluated on a case by case basis.
