SUBJECT: NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF RISK MANAGEMENT DIRECTIVE FOR OCCUPATIONAL BYSTANDER CANCER RISK OF THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT 1,3-DICHLOROPROPENE AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) has issued a risk management directive (RMD) to guide the development and adoption of mitigation measures to address occupational bystander cancer risk from the active ingredient 1,3-dichloropropene (also referenced as 1,3-D or Telone).
